



BEES AND HONEY



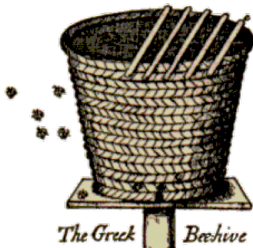
An introduction

This course will explore man's relationship with the honey bee and the ways in which bees have been kept for millennia as a source of wax and honey.



The history of beekeeping will be brought right up to date with a look at the wide range of hives in use around the world today.

There will be a chance to look inside a living hive and search for the queen, observe the waggle dance, and see the workers making and storing wax and honey.

In the final session we will remove comb from a hive and extract the honey, spinning it out by hand in a special honey extractor and putting it in jars.

You can even take a jar of fresh, straight from the hive honey home with you.
