Gardening tips for summer



- If you need to water the garden while it is hot early morning or late evening is best.
- Try applying a mulch to keep your water consumption down.
- Dead head your flowers which may encourage repeat flowering.
- Now is the time to collect your flower seeds for sowing next spring - make sure you label them so you know what they are.
